

Jeopardy Instructions

- 1 Divide the chalkboard or dry erase board into a grid. Write a category title in the first box of each column. Fill in the rest of the column boxes with point values in ascending order.
- 2 Prepare as many questions and corresponding answers as there are boxes on the grid. Harder questions should be worth more points. Compile this information on a sheet from which you, the moderator, will read during the game. Choose 3-4 Daily Doubles at your discretion.
- 3 Divide the class into teams. I like having 3 teams. Flip a coin to determine which team will get the chance to answer the first question. Make sure each team can see and read the board clearly. Assign someone to keep score and to keep time when students must answer (5 seconds). Using a bell it good for this to let students know time is up.
- 4 Ask the first team to select a point value from any category. Read the answer corresponding to the question. Cross out the question on your sheet to keep track. I don't require students to provide a response in the form of a question. Each group is given 5 SECONDS to answer a question. (assign someone to ring the bell after 5 seconds). If they answer correctly, they get the points. If they answer incorrectly, they get the points deducted.
- 5 Give other teams a chance to answer if the first group cannot provide the correct response, which they then win the points. If they guess incorrectly, they must get the points deducted; so remind them to only guess if they know the answer. Have the score keeper put an "X" through the corresponding box on the grid once the question has been answered. To allow everyone a chance, let the next team go, even if the current team answers correctly.
- 6 Have the score keeper write the points earned under the team names each time a team answers a question on the board.
- 7 I usually make the team choose one person from their team to answer the daily double; no one can answer but that designated student. If they guess correctly, they get double the points. If they guess incorrectly, they get double the points deducted. (you can get minus points in jeopardy)
- 8 Continue to play Jeopardy until all but one box has been eliminated from the grid.
- 9 The FINAL round is the last question on the grid! Give teams the question. On their pad, they must bet a certain amount of points. If they get the answer right, that number is added to their points. If wrong, it is deducted. They have 30 seconds to quietly confer with their team members to answer the question. If they guess nothing, they do not get a chance to win. Give them a maximum amount to bet.
